Chicago Brewing District's Dancing in the Streets Brings First-ever Jam Band & Craft Beer Festival to West Town

Dancing in the Streets Features Two Days of Craft Beer and Jam Bands, August 4-5

CHICAGO (July 12, 2018) – The West Town Chamber of Commerce has partnered with the Chicago Brewing District, the Industrial Council of Nearwest Chicago, and On Tour Brewing to present the first-ever Dancing in the Streets jam band and brew festival. Featuring 10 craft beer varieties from the Chicago Brewing District brewers and touring jam bands booked by On Tour Brewing, the one-of-a-kind festival will also boast an array of local artisans and makers from the Kinzie Industrial corridor, West Town restaurants, retailers and food trucks for patrons to enjoy all weekend long.
